Aerospace sector: DAHER wins new logistics service contract with Aircelle

DAHER, the integrated equipment and services supplier, is setting up a 70,000 sq ft logistics platform at Le Havre and is to recruit 80 people in 2008 to carry out the new activities.

For three years, DAHER has been working on site for Aircelle, of the SAFRAN group, in Le Havre, delivering industrial services spanning **receipt of incoming flows through to line-side supply**. DAHER personnel working for Aircelle has increased from 15 to 80 over the three year period.

In response to strong growth in the aerospace sector led by increased throughput on existing programmes and the startup of new programmes, including the A380, **Aircelle has launched a project to optimize logistics flows at its Le Havre plant.**

Under this initiative, Aircelle opted to outsource the plant's supply logistics and in 2007 issued an invitation to tender for comprehensive services including the creation of a logistics platform and management of plant procurement flows.

To carry out this mission, DAHER has equipped a 70,000 sq ft logistics platform at Le Havre entirely devoted to Aircelle and situated 6 km from the Le Havre plant. This platform provides a facility for **receiving, storing and distributing parts and equipment to the production stations.**

The startup phase of this new **three-year contract**, representing in the region of **20 million euros**, commenced January 1st. In the course of 2008, DAHER **plans to recruit 80 additional staff to the project, chiefly engineers, warehouse operatives and forklift operators.**

The new contract, which expands the scope of the mission entrusted to Daher, is testimony to the confidence Aircelle places in the group. DAHER, with its recognized expertise in the aerospace sector, is taking care of all industrial services and investing both organizationally and in terms of information systems to optimize Aircelle logistics flows as effectively as possible.
