DAHER plans to accelerate the growth of the business and launch new investments, in particular with a dedicated fleet of tractors and trailers, new handling facilities and increased storage and packaging capacity.

Through this acquisition, DAHER accelerates its development in the nuclear sector and continues the progressive implementation of a global "manufacturing and services" solution, in line with its Ambition 2010 strategic plan.
