DAHER has acquired several industrial service companies in Spain specialised in the Automotive sector: UNIGEL and five SESE Group subsidiaries

These acquisitions represent total revenues of €16 million altogether, and 370 jobs spread over the 10 operating plants that are located in the major Spanish employment basins. The new consolidation scope is grouped around UNIGEL.

Their activities are exclusively aimed at the Manufacturing industry: two-thirds are devoted to Automakers and OEMs in the Automotive sector and the Defence industry.

This is a strategic acquisition for DAHER as a result of the synergies between the **Automotive** and **Defence** sectors and its other major sectors of reference: **Aerospace** and the **Nuclear** industry. These synergies exist from the standpoint of duplication of mutual skill enrichment and in terms of complementary economic cycles.

Moreover, this acquisition falls within the framework of DAHER's international expansion strategy.

Finally, this acquisition confirms DAHER's positioning as an industrial service group that designs and manufactures customized equipment and services for very high-tech industries.

Founded in 1993 and located in close proximity to the major Spanish industrial centers, including Madrid, Barcelona, Seville, Gijón, etc., UNIGEL provides industrial logistics services for high technology sectors. These services include complex operations that integrate its customers' industrial processes, as in the case of automotive assembly (cable harnesses, headrests, etc.), pre-cut material deliveries, as well as painting and polishing of parts.
