in a new platform located in the Aeroconstellation zone**

Highly visible in the Midi-Pyrenees region for several decades now, DAHER has just combined four of its Toulouse sites into a new platform located close to the AIRBUS plant, the Jean Luc LAGARDERE site.

By combining a design office, a logistics platform, a road transport branch and an international transport organisation branch on a new, unique modern site, DAHER is concentrating its regional presence and is providing a new tool for industrial groups in the aerospace sector that directly meets their needs.

Located on the Chemin d'ULIET, in the town of CORNEBARIEU, this new platform is set in grounds of over 25,000 sq. m and includes 1,600 sq. m of offices for approximately 100 people, including around thirty design and development engineers, a warehouse of about 5,000 sq. m and a parking area for specific trailers dedicated to the transport of aircraft sections and equipment.
