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Nuclear: new British contract for DAHER, the equipment and services supplier

The European equipment and services supplier designs, manufactures, certifies and tests new 3m³ containers for the long-term storage of nuclear waste for the British market

SELLAFIELD Ltd, which was created after the reorganisation of the British Nuclear Group, has signed a contract of several million pounds with DAHER for the **design and development of new generation containers** for the long-term storage of medium-activity nuclear waste.

DAHER is an equipment and services supplier in the nuclear supply chain which is organised around the life cycle of the fuel, power facilities and research reactors.

DAHER, via its sites in Derby in the United Kingdom and Montrichard in France, will be responsible for **the design, certification and testing of new 3m³ containers before delivering an initial batch to SELLAFIELD for complete assessment**. With its site in Derby, DAHER will also provide assistance in making the containers available.

The decision to design new containers follows recommendations by the Committee on Radioactive Waste Management (CoRWM) in the United Kingdom, published in July 2006. DAHER obtained this contract following an international request for bids.

DAHER's ability to design and manufacture containers for the entire nuclear cycle is based on extensive experience and tried-and-tested methods, with an auditable quality reference guideline and an expanding portfolio of nuclear products.

This contract confirms DAHER's development strategy in the nuclear sector with the creation of a centre of excellence in France and the acquisition in April 2007 of the German company NCS, (NUCLEAR CARGO Services), previously a subsidiary of Deutsche Bahn which specialised in nuclear transport.

Through the SELLAFIELD contract, DAHER, which already counts throughout Europe customers such as the CEA, EDF, AREVA, GNS and RWE Nukem, is reinforcing its presence in the nuclear sector.
